The year 2017 marks the 100th anniversary of the two major victories of the Canadian Army along the Western Front, the capture of Vimy Ridge and Passchendaele. We will be examining the actions of the Canadian Corps in 1917 as well as discovering their other actions in the Great War. In addition, the tour will focus on some of the main campaign areas of the Canadian, British and American Armies that fought in Belgium and France during the First and Second World Wars. Join retired history teacher and battlefield guide John Hetherington on this unique educational journey across the battlefields of Western Europe. Day 1: Flight

Toronto - Paris Overnight service to Paris

Day 2: Amiens

Depart from Paris, Travel to Amiens. Day at your leisure to visit Amiens Cathedral. Overnight Amiens, France.

Day 3: Battle of the Somme

Lochnagar crater, Beaumont Hamel battlefield, Tank memorial, Courcelette. Overnight Amiens, France.

Day 4: Battle of Vimy Ridge

Wellington caves, Vimy Ridge and Neuville St. Vaast war cemetery. Overnight Ypres, Belgium.

Day 5: In Flanders Fields

Essex Farm cemetery. "John McCrae"

Vancouver Corner memorial, Langemarck, Passchendaele, Last Post ceremonies. Overnight Ypres, Belgium.

Day 6: Atlantic Wall

Todt gun battery Audinghen, John McCrae grave. Overnight Boulogne, France.

Day 7: Dieppe

Dieppe raid tour. Overnight Dieppe, France.

Day 8: Battle of Normandy Eastern Approaches

Merville battery, Pegasus Bridge museum. Overnight Bayeux, France.

Day 9: Normandy Eastern Approaches

Juno Beach. Beny-sur-mer Canadian war cemetery, Mulberry Harbour, Longue gun battery. Overnight Bayeux, France.

Day 10: Normandy Western Approaches

American war cemetery Omaha Beach. Afternoon at your leisure in Bayeux Overnight Bayeux, France.

Day 11: Bayeux to Paris

Morning departure from Bayeux to Paris Afternoon at your leisure in Paris.

Day 12: Paris

Full day of Paris at your own leisure. Overnight Paris, France.

Day 13: Departure

Morning departure flight Paris to Toronto.

BOOKING PROCEDURE:

DEPOSIT:

\$950.00 per person. The deposit is non-refundable and due at time of booking. Your insurance premium is also due at this time.

FORM OF PAYMENT

Cheque payable to: Verstraete Travel & Cruises.

PAYMENT BY CREDIT CARD:

There is a \$95.00 pp surcharge for payment by credit card.

PAYMENT SCHEDULE:

Deposit is due at time of booking with your selected insurance premium.

BOOKING DEADLINE:

CANCELLATION:
